A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to make further provision to prevent the Introduction of Imbecile Persons into New Zealand. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 5     1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Imbecile Passengers Act Extension Act, 1879." Short Title.
- 2. Section six of "The Imbecile Passengers Act, 1873," is hereby amended by the omission therefrom of the words following, that is to say,— "Imbecile Passengers Act, 1873," amended.
- 10     "Nor to the crews of ships who shall have signed articles for the whole voyage."
- 3. The provisions of "The Imbecile Passengers Act, 1873," and any Act amending the same, shall extend to the crew of any ship, and to all persons on board and belonging in any capacity to any ship, in the same manner as the said provisions apply to passengers by any Act to extend to crews of vessels.
