A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT for the amendment of "The Kaitangata Relief Fund Title.  
Transfer Act, 1892."

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in  
5 Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Kaitangata Relief Fund Short Title.  
Transfer Act Amendment Act, 1893."

2. The Trustees for the time being of the Kaitangata Relief  
10 Fund are hereby authorised, from time to time, as they shall think Trustees may vary sums granted to beneficiaries, and add to their number.  
fit, to increase or decrease the amounts paid out of the said fund to any present or future beneficiary, and also, if they shall see occasion, may altogether stop the amount paid to any such beneficiary either wholly or temporarily, and also, in any case of distress, may  
15 restore upon such list the name of any such beneficiary who, from any cause, may have ceased or may cease to receive contributions from the said fund.
