3. Nothing in this Act shall extend to the expenditure of any Act not to authorise moneys of a local authority in paying or refunding any travelling or payment of personal 20 other personal expenses incurred by any member of a local authority. members.

4. For the purposes of this Act the term "local authority" "Local authority means a Borough Council, County Council, Road Board, Town defined. Board, or Harbour Board.
