A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Legislative Council Act, 1914.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 5 1. This Act may be cited as the Legislative Council Amendment Act, 1916, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Legislative Council Act, 1914 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act). Short Title.
- 10 2. Section one of the principal Act is hereby amended by repealing subsection two thereof, and substituting the following subsection:— Date of commencement of principal Act postponed.

“(2.) This Act, except section twenty-three hereof, shall commence on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and twenty.”
- 15 3. Section twelve of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting the words “the first day of January, nineteen hundred and sixteen,” and substituting the words “the first day of January, nineteen hundred and twenty.” Date of first election under principal Act postponed.
- 20 4. (1.) Section twenty-three of the principal Act, as amended by section two of the Legislative Council Amendment Act, 1915, is hereby amended by omitting from subsection two the words “the first day of September, nineteen hundred and seventeen,” and substituting the words “the first day of January, nineteen hundred and twenty.” Duration of new appointments extended.
- 25 (2.) The said section twenty-three is hereby further amended by omitting the words “the first day of July, nineteen hundred and twenty-one,” and substituting the words “the first day of January, nineteen hundred and twenty-four.”
- 30 5. The Legislative Council Amendment Act, 1915, is hereby repealed. Repeal.
