**A BILL INTITULED**

**AN ACT** to amend "The Regulation of Local Elections Act, 1876." Title.

**BE IT ENACTED** by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Local Elections Act 1876 Amendment Act, 1899." Short Title.

2. Section twenty-eight of "The Regulation of Local Elections Act, 1876," is hereby amended by the insertion after the first paragraph of the following words: "and, after securing the said corner by gum or otherwise, shall stamp thereon an official mark, and shall draw a line in pencil or ink through the name and number of such voter on the roll, as evidence that he has rendered his vote." Section 28 of "The Regulation of Local Elections Act, 1876," amended.
