1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Legislative Officers' Short Title. Salaries Act 1867 Amendment Act, 1893."

2. The Schedule to the said Act of 1867 is hereby repealed, and Repeal. the Schedule hereto is substituted instead thereof.

3. This Act shall come into operation from the first day of Operation of Act. January, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-four.
