A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Legislative Officers' Salaries Act, 1867."

WHEREAS it is expedient to revise the salaries of the chief officers of the Legislature of New Zealand: Preamble.

5 BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Legislative Officers' Salaries Act 1867 Amendment Act, 1893." Short Title.

10 2. The Schedule to the said Act of 1867 is hereby repealed, and the Schedule hereto is substituted instead thereof. Repeal.

3. This Act shall come into operation from the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-four. Operation of Act.
