A BILL INTITULED

An Acr to amend "The Mines Act, 1877."

Title.

WHEREAS it is desirable that "The Mines Act, 1877," should be Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Mines Act 1877 Amend- Short Title. ment Act, 1884."

2. From and after the commencement of this Act the words Reduction in the "one pound" in the fifth line of clause twelve and in the seventeenth charge for miner's clause line of clause thirteen of "The Mines Act, 1877," are hereby repealed, and the words "ten shillings" substituted in lieu thereof.

3. From and after the commencement of this Act the word Reduction in the "three" in the fifth line of clause twenty-five of "The Mines Act, charge for business 1877," is hereby repealed, and the word "one" substituted in lieu thereof. In the sixth line of the same clause of the said Act the word "five" is hereby repealed, and the word "two" substituted in lieu thereof.

4. This Act shall come into operation on the first day of When Act to come into operation. January, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five.
