A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1876."
 WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1876" (hereinafter called "the said Act"):

Title.
 Preamble.

5 BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Municipal Corporations Act 1876 Amendment Act, 1884, No. 2."

Short Title.

10 2. Section ten of "The Municipal Corporations Acts Amendment Act, 1880," is hereby repealed, and the following is substituted therefor:—

Proposal for special loan must be agreed to by a majority of the voters voting.

15 If the number of votes given for the proposal exceeds the number given against it, the resolution in favour of the proposal shall be deemed to be carried, and the Council may proceed with the proposal accordingly; but if not, then the resolution shall be deemed to be rejected, and the Council shall not so proceed.

20 3. The Council of the Borough of Sydenham may, by special order, with the consent of the owners by deed, declare any private street within the said borough laid out before the twentieth day of September, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven, notwithstanding that such private street is of any less width than forty feet, and that no petition shall have been presented to the Council in accordance with subsection two of section two hundred and eleven
 25 of "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1876," to be, and such private street shall, from the day named in such special order, become, a public street: Provided that such private street shall, previous to the date of such special order, have been formed, metalled, and otherwise constructed in such manner and of such materials as the Council
 30 approves.

Sydenham Borough Council may declare streets laid out before 20th September, 1877, to be public streets.

The Council may also, by special order, without such consent as aforesaid, declare any such private street to be, and such private street shall, from the day named in such special order, become, a public street, subject however to subsection two of section two hundred and eleven of the said Act: Provided that, prior to the 5 date of such special order, such private street shall have been formed, metalled, and otherwise constructed in such manner and of such materials as the Council approves.

The provisions of the one hundred and eighty-fifth section of the said Act, and all other provisions of any Act affecting public streets, 10 shall, from the day named in such special order, apply to such private streets.
