## A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1876." WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Municipal Corporations Preamble. Act, 1876" (hereinafter called "the said Act"):

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Municipal Corporations Short Title. Act 1876 Amendment Act, 1884, No. 2." •

2. Section ten of "The Municipal Corporations Acts Amendment Proposal for special 10 Act, 1880," is hereby repealed, and the following is substituted therefor:-
