An Acr to constitute the Malvern County.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as 5 follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Malvern County Act, 1910.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the first day of Date to come into

November, nineteen hundred and ten.

3. (1.) The Malvern County is hereby constituted, and shall Malvern County 10 comprise all that area the boundaries whereof are particularly described in the First Schedule hereto, being those portions of the

Selwyn County known as the Courtenay, South Malvern, and East Malvern Road Districts.

(2.) The boundaries of the Selwyn County are hereby altered Boundaries of 15 accordingly, and shall be as described in the Second Schedule hereto. selwyn altered.

4. The Courtenay, South Malvern, and East Malvern Road Courtenay, South Districts are hereby abolished, and shall be deemed to be merged Malvern, and East Malvern Road within the Malvern County; and the provisions of section thirty-six Districts abolished.

(3.) Nothing in this section shall affect the right of the Selwyn County Council on the constitution of the Malvern County to an apportionment under paragraph (d) of section fifteen of the Counties 10 Act, 1908, of its liability for the interest and sinking fund of any loan raised by the Selwyn County for the construction, maintenance,

or repair of water-races in the Malvern County.

(4.) All such water-races shall be constructed, repaired, and maintained by the Selwyn County Council at the expense of the 15 Malvern and Selwyn County Councils in such proportions as the said Councils agree upon, or, in case they cannot agree, then in such proportions as the Minister of Public Works determines.

(5.) In case the Selwyn County Council fails to maintain and expenses on default. keep in good repair the said water-races, the Malvern County Council 20 at any time after seven days' notice given to the Selwyn County Council requiring it to make the necessary repairs may do, execute, and carry out all works, acts, and things that it may think necessary for such purpose, and may recover from the Selwyn County Council all costs, charges, and expenses incurred in such maintenance and 25 repair, and all costs, charges, and expenses incurred by it through neglect of the Selwyn County Council to maintain and repair as aforesaid.

> (6.) All moneys accruing from the said water-races shall be divided between the county funds of the Selwyn and Malvern County 30 Councils in such proportions as those Councils agree upon, or, in case they cannot agree, then in such proportions as the Minister of Public Works determines.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

COUNTY OF MALVERN.

ALL that area in the Provincial District of Canterbury the boundaries whereof are as follows: Commencing at the northernmost corner of Rural Section 3107, Block 3, Hororata Survey District; thence north-easterly, south-easterly, and in a general direction northerly, following the boundary of the Tawera County to the northernmost corner of Rural Section 4739, Block 8, Kowai Survey District, on the bank of the River Waimakariri; thence north-easterly by the production of the north-western boundary-line of that section to the centre of the River Waimakariri; thence southeasterly by a line along the middle of that river to the boundary of the Templeton Road District; thence southerly along the boundary of that road district to the Great South Road; thence south-westerly along that road to the southern railway, thence again south-westerly along that railway to the centre of the Selwyn River; thence north-westerly by a line along the centre of that river to a point opposite the northernmost corner of Rural Section 3107; thence north-easterly by a straight line to the commencing-point.

Also all that area in the Canterbury Land District bounded towards the north generally by the Waimairi County from the City of Christchurch to the Borough of New Brighton; thence towards the east generally by the Borough of New Brighton to the estuary of the Heathcote and Avon Rivers; thence towards the south-east by the said estuary to the north-eastern boundary of the Borough of Woolston; and thence towards the south-west generally by the Borough of Woolston and the City of ·Christchurch to the place of commencement.

(4.) All such water-races shall be constructed, repaired, and maintained by the Selwyn County Council at the expense of the 15 Malvern and Selwyn County Councils in such proportions as the said Councils agree upon, or, in case they cannot agree, then in such

proportions as the Minister of Public Works determines.

(5.) In case the Selwyn County Council fails to maintain and keep in good repair the said water-races, the Malvern County Council 20 at any time after seven days' notice given to the Selwyn County Council requiring it to make the necessary repairs may do, execute, and carry out all works, acts, and things that it may think necessary for such purpose, and may recover from the Selwyn County Council all costs, charges, and expenses incurred in such maintenance and 25 repair, and all costs, charges, and expenses incurred by it through neglect of the Selwyn County Council to maintain and repair as aforesaid.

(6.) All moneys accruing from the said water-races shall be divided between the county funds of the Selwyn and Malvern County 30 Councils in such proportions as those Councils agree upon, or, in case they cannot agree, then in such proportions as the Minister of

Public Works determines.

6. (1.) Notwithstanding anything in subsection two of section five of the Tawera County Act, 1909, contained, the water-race 35 known as the Malvern Water-race and all the water-races as defined by the Water-supply Act, 1908, at present being in the Tawera County and deemed to be vested in the Selwyn County Council as provided by subsection two of section five of the Tawera County Act, 1909, shall be deemed to be vested in the Malvern County Council 40 as if the same had been so vested by agreement as provided by sections fifty-two and fifty-three of the Water-supply Act, 1908; and as regards such water-race or water-races the Malvern County Council shall have and may exercise all the powers and authorities conferred upon County Councils by the Counties Act, 1908, and the 45 Water-supply Act, 1908.

(2.) All references in subsections four, five, and six of section five of the Tawera County Act, 1909, to the Selwyn County Council shall be construed to apply to the Malvern County Council as constituted under this Act as if the words "Malvern County Council" 50 had been inserted in such subsections for the words "Selwyn County
