A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to make deductions from any Sum payable to and receivable  
 by certain Members of the Legislature as their Expenses or  
 Honorarium during the present Session. Title.

5 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in  
 Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Members' Honorarium  
 Reduction Act, 1884." Short Title.

2. There shall be deducted from any sum that may be payable  
 10 during the present session of Parliament in respect of the expenses  
 or honorarium of each member of the House of Representatives and  
 Legislative Council who was in attendance during the last session of  
 the last Parliament, an amount equal to *five* pounds per diem for  
 every day in respect of which each such member was paid for such  
 15 attendance. Honorarium of
