A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend the law relating to Maoris and Maori land, and for other purposes

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—(1) This Act may be cited as the Maori Purposes Act 1973.

10 (2) This Act shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April 1973.

2. Estate duty in respect of Maori land interests—

(1) Section 78 of the Maori Affairs Amendment Act 1967 is hereby amended by omitting from the proviso to subsection 15 (1) the words “nineteen hundred and seventy-three”, and substituting the words “nineteen hundred and seventy-five”.

(2) Section 78 of the Maori Affairs Amendment Act 1967 is hereby further amended by omitting from subsection (2) 20 the words “nineteen hundred and seventy-three”, and substituting the words “nineteen hundred and seventy-five”.

3. Ngaitahu Maori Trust Board—Section 6 of the Maori Trust Boards Act 1955 is hereby amended by omitting from subsection (2) the words “up to and including the year nineteen hundred and seventy-three”.
