A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to authorize the Detention for a limited Time of certain Native Title. Prisoners.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :----

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Maori Prisoners Detention Short Title. Act, 1880."

2. All Natives who, on or since the eighteenth day of July instant, have Natives arrested $\mathbf{5}$ been arrested in that part of the colony situated between the White Cliffs and deemed to be the River Waitotara, on the West Coast of the North Island, or who may here-after during the existence of this Act be arrested there or in any other part of Act, 1880." the West Coast, shall be deemed to have been and to be detained under the

10 provisions of "The Maori Prisoners Act, 1880," as effectually as if such Natives were included within the terms of that Act.

Provided that the detention authorized by this Act shall in no case extend beyond the last day of October next.

3. The term "Native" in this Act means any person of the aboriginal Interpretation of term "Native." 15 native race, and includes any half-caste of such race.
