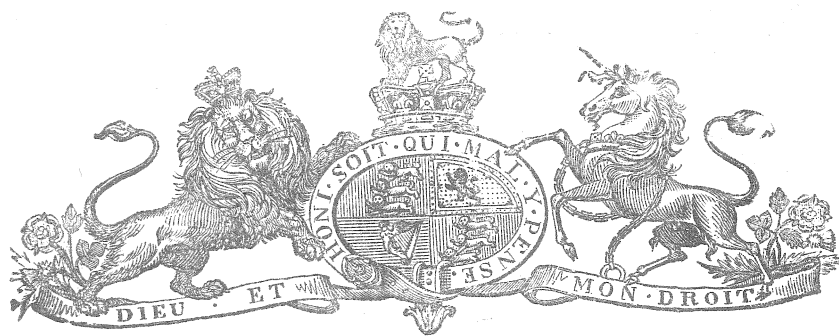

AN ACT to appropriate the sum of £2,500 to defray the expense of a Council of Native Chiefs to be held in the year 1861.

WHEREAS it is expedient that a Council of Native Chiefs of the Colony of New Zealand should be held in the year 1861 ;

And whereas an Act has been passed in the present Session of the General Assembly, intituled "The New Zealand Loan Act, 1860," whereby the Governor of the said Colony is authorised to raise upon the security, in manner therein mentioned, a sum not exceeding £150,000, for the service of the Colony ;

And whereas it is expedient that a sum of £2,500 out of the said Loan should be appropriated for defraying the expense of the said Council ;

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand, in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

I. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Native Council Expenses Appropriation Act, 1860."

II. Out of any monies to be raised by virtue of the said Act there may be issued and applied in such manner as the Governor shall think fit any sums not exceeding in the whole the sum of £2,500, for the purpose of defraying the expense of a Council of Native Chiefs to be held in the year 1861.

Treasurer to make
payments under War-
rant of the Governor.

III. The Treasurer of the Colony shall issue and pay the said sums for such purpose to such person, upon such days and in such proportions as the Governor, by any Warrant under his hand, shall, from time to time, order and direct.
