## A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend "The Newmarket Hall Act, 1874."

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend an Act passed by the Super- Preamble. intendent and Provincial Council of the now abolished Province of 5 Auckland, intituled "The Newmarket Hall Act, 1874," hereinafter termed "the said Act":

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Newmarket Hall Act Short Title. 10 1874 Amendment Act, 1893."

2. Section two of the said Act is hereby repealed, and in lieu Land how vested. thereof it is enacted as follows:—

The management and administration of the said land, and of any 15 buildings now or hereafter to be erected thereon, is hereby vested in the Mayor and Councillors for the time being of the Borough of Newmarket.

3. Section eight of the said Act is hereby repealed.
