A BILL INTITULED

An Act to empower the Nelson Hospital and Charitable Aid Board Title. to sell a certain Parcel of Land in the City of Nelson upon such Terms and Conditions as they shall think fit, and to apply the Proceeds of such Sale in or towards the Erection of an Old People's Home in the said City.

WHEREAS the parcel of land described in the Schedule hereto is Proamble. vested under and by virtue of the Nelson Hospital Reserves Act, 1888,

- in the Nelson Hospital and Charitable Aid Board for the purposes 10 of a general hospital at Nelson, subject to the provisions of the Hospitals and Charitable Institutions Act, 1885: And whereas the said parcel of land and the buildings thereon now used for an Old People's Home are unsuitable for such purpose, and the Nelson Hospital and Charitable Aid Board have secured another and more
- 15 suitable site for the erection of a new building for an Old People's Home, and the said parcel of land will therefore be no longer required for such purpose: And whereas it is desirable and expedient that the said parcel of land should be sold and the proceeds applied by the said Board as hereinafter provided:

- (a.) To sell the said parcel of land and the buildings thereon, either together or in lots, by public auction or public tender, for such price and upon such terms and conditions as to the Board shall seem fit:

(b.) To execute under the seal of the Board all necessary conveyances, transfers, and assurances of the said parcel of land or any part thereof to the purchaser or purchasers thereof.

Application of purchase-moneys.

4. All purchase-moneys received by the Board for the sale of 10 the said parcel of land or buildings, or any part thereof, shall be applied in or towards the erection of a building or buildings for an Old People's Home upon the land already acquired for that purpose, being sections numbered 984, 986, and 988 on the map of the City of Nelson, and any surplus shall be held and applied by the Board 15 for the same purposes as the ordinary fund of the said Board.
