A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to vest in the Corporation of the Town of Invercargill a certain Reserve in the Campbelltown Hundred. Title.

WHEREAS the parcel of land described in the Schedule hereto has been reserved from sale for the purposes of a pilot station for the Port of New River, and it is expedient that the same should be vested in the Corporation of the Town of Invercargill : Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The New River Pilot Station Reserve Act, 1879." Short Title.

2. The parcel of land described in the said Schedule to this Act shall be and the same is hereby vested in the Corporation of the Town of Invercargill and their successors for an estate of inheritance in fee-simple. Land vested in the Corporation.

3. The said land shall be deemed to be land vested in the said Corporation under "The New River Harbour Management Act, 1877," and shall and may be dealt with in all respects by the Municipal Council of the Town of Invercargill, as if the same land had been vested in the said Corporation under the said Act. Land to be dealt with under "The New River Harbour Management Act, 1877."

SCHEDULE.

ALL that parcel of land in the Southland Division of the Provincial District of Otago, situated in the Campbelltown Hundred, known as the Pilot Station Reserve, estimated to contain one thousand and ninety (1,090) acres, more or less. Bounded towards the North by the New River estuary ; towards the South-east by a Native Reserve ; and towards the South and West by Foveaux Strait : as the same is delineated on the plan deposited in the Survey Office, Invercargill.
