## A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to extend the Benefits of "The Old-age Pensions Act, Title. 1898," to Naturalised Subjects in certain Cases.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in 5 Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :-

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Naturalised Subjects Short Title. Relief Act, 1899."

2. The disability imposed on naturalised subjects by subsection Disability of 10 three of section sixty-four of "The Old-age Pensions Act, 1898," naturalised subject (not being a subject as to old-age pensions Chinese or other Asiatic) who has been naturalised in New Zealand restricted. for not less than twelve months next preceding the date of his pension-claim, anything in the aforesaid section sixty-four to the 15 contrary notwithstanding.
