2. Disability of naturalised subjects as to old-age pensions restricted.

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to extend the Benefits of "The Old-age Pensions Act, 1898," to Naturalised Subjects in certain Cases. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Naturalised Subjects Relief Act, 1899." Short Title.

2. The disability imposed on naturalised subjects by subsection three of section sixty-four of "The Old-age Pensions Act, 1898," shall not apply in the case of any naturalised subject (not being a Chinese or other Asiatic) who has been naturalised in New Zealand for not less than twelve months next preceding the date of his pension-claim, anything in the aforesaid section sixty-four to the contrary notwithstanding. Disability of naturalised subjects as to old-age pensions restricted.
