### A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to validate the Election of Members of the Ohakune Town Board. Title

WHEREAS by Proclamation dated the tenth day of July, nineteen hundred and eight, the Town District of Ohakune was constituted: Preamble.  
And whereas at the first election of the Board of Commissioners for the said district, held on the eleventh day of August, nineteen hundred and eight, the valuation roll for the Ohakune Riding was in error substituted for the electoral roll of that riding and used in lieu thereof: And whereas it is expedient to validate the said election:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows.—

1. This Act may be cited as the Ohakune Town Board Election Validation Act, 1908. Short Title.

2. The members of the Ohakune Town Board who were elected on the eleventh day of August, nineteen hundred and eight, are hereby declared to have been validly elected. Validation of election of Ohakune Town Board.
