A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend "The Privileges Act, 1866." Title

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Privileges Act 1866 Short Title. 5 Amendment Act, 1878."

2. The Schedule to the said Act shall be amended by adding schedule amended. thereto the words "The Clerk-Assistant of the Legislative Council."

3. Clauses seven, eight, nine, and twelve of the said Act shall be Clauses 7, 8, 9, an 1 amended by adding the words "or Acting Speaker," whenever the word 12 amended.

10 "Speaker" is used in the said clauses immediately after the said word Speaker, and the said clauses shall be read and interpreted in all respect as if the said words "or Acting Speaker" had been originally introduced and formed part of the said clauses.
