A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Patents Act, 1870."

 $B^{\rm E}$ IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :-

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Patents Act Amendment Short Title. 5 Act, 1879.'

2. The form of notice set forth in the First Schedule to this Act Alteration of form of is hereby substituted for the form set forth in the Second Schedule to notice of intention to proceed with "The Patents Act, 1870" (herein termed "the said Act"), and "proceed with such notice shall be published once only in the *Gazette* and news-^{Patent.} 10 papers prescribed by the tenth section of the said Act.

3. The sixteenth section of the said Act shall be read as if the Amendment of words "not being more than one month" had never been inserted Patents Act, 1870." therein.

4. The fees to be paid in respect of the several matters mentioned Alteration in scale of 15 in the thirty-eighth section of the said Act, and in the Eighth Schedule fees payable under said Acts. thereto, shall be those specified in the Second Schedule to this Act; and the scale of fees hereby provided for shall come into force on the first day of January next, and shall apply to all matters and things then pending, or in respect of which any such fee is payable.
