AN ACT to amend "The Patents Act, 1870."

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

The form of notice set forth in the First Schedule to this Act is hereby substituted for the form set forth in the Second Schedule to "The Patents Act, 1870," (hereinafter termed "the said Act,") and such notice, being published by the Patent Officer once only in the <i>Gazette</i>, at the time prescribed by the tenth section of the said Act, shall be sufficient publication within the meaning of the said section.</p> <p>3. The fourteenth section of the said Act is hereby amended by inserting therein the word "five" in lieu of the word "three" where it occurs in the said section.</p> <p>4. The sixteenth section of the said Act shall be read as if the words "not being more than one month" had never been inserted therein.</p> <p>5. The fees to be paid in respect of the several matters mentioned in the thirty-eighth section of the said Act, and in the Eighth Schedule thereto, shall be those specified in the Second Schedule to this Act; and the scale of fees hereby provided for shall come into force on the first day of January next, and shall apply to all matters and things then pending, or in respect of which any such fee is payable.</p> <p>6.
