A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Pharmacy Act, 1898."

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as 5 follows :---

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Pharmacy Act Amend- short Title. ment Act, 1902"; and it shall form part of and be read together with "The Pharmacy Act, 1898" (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act").

10 2. In addition to the fees specified in the Eighth Schedule to Annual membership the principal Act there shall be payable, on or before the first day of August in each year, by every registered chemist an annual membership fee of *ten* shillings.

3. It shall be lawful for the Board to erase from the Register Erasure from 15 the name of any registered chemist who fails to pay such annual fee Register on non-payment. within twelve months after the same becomes due.

4. If at any time after such erasure the person whose name was Re-registration. so erased applies to the Board to be reinstated as a registered chemist, his name shall be re-entered on the Register on payment 20 by him of the registration fee fixed by the said Eighth Schedule.
