An Act to amend the Pensions Act, 1913.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as 5 follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Pensions Amendment Act, Short Title. 1914, and shall form part of and be read together with the Pensions Act, 1913 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Section two of the principal Act is hereby amended—

(a.) By inserting before the word "allowance" in the definition principal Act of "income" the words "voluntary or other";

(b.) By omitting from the definition of "widow" all words after the words "the Mental Defectives Act, 1911."

3. Section eight of the principal Act is hereby amended by Section 8 of 15 omitting the word "occasional."
