A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend the Pensions Act, 1913.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as 5 follows:-

1. This Act may be cited as the Pensions Amendment Act, short Title. 1914, and shall form part of and be read together with the Pensions Act, 1913 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Section two of the principal Act is hereby amended—

(a.) By inserting before the word "allowance" in paragraph (i) principal Act of the definition of "income" the words "voluntary or other";

(b.) By omitting from the definition of "widow" all words after the words "the Mental Defectives Act, 1911."

3. Section eight of the principal Act is hereby amended by Section 8 of omitting the word "occasional" from paragraph (b) thereof.

4. Section thirteen of the principal Act is hereby amended by

adding the following subsection:

"(3.) The accumulated property or yearly income of a pensioner 20 whose property or income has been computed in accordance with this section shall not be deemed to be increased during the currency of a pension by reason merely of the death of the husband or wife of the pensioner.

5. Section nineteen of the principal Act is hereby amended by Section 19 of 25 repealing paragraphs (b), (c), and (d), and substituting the following principal Act paragraph:--

"(b.) For each additional child to whom this Part of this Act applies the pension shall be increased by six pounds a year."

6. Section twenty-three of the principal Act is hereby amended by adding the following subsection:—

"(2.) For the purposes of this and the next succeeding section

New Zealand includes the Cook Islands."

7. Section seventy-one of the principal Act is hereby amended

by adding the following subsection:—

"(3.) For the purposes of this section a woman who ceased to be a British subject by reason merely of her marriage with an alien since deceased or from whom she is legally separated shall not be deemed to be an alien."
