An Act to amend the Police Act 1958

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand 5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Police Amendment Act 1961, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Police Act 1958* (hereinafter referred to as the 10 principal Act).

2. Appointment of Superintendents—Section 7 of the principal Act is hereby amended by adding, as subsection (2) thereof, the following subsection:

"(2) Any appointment under this section to the rank of 15 Superintendent shall be made from those commissioned officers for the time being holding the rank of Chief Inspector."

3. Promotion Board to recommend certain appointments and promotions—Section 13 of the principal Act is hereby amended by repealing subsection (1), and substituting the

following subsection:

"(1) Subject to the provisions of this Act, every appointment under section 7 or section 8 of this Act to any rank below the rank of Superintendent, every appointment under section 12 of this Act to any commissioned or noncommissioned rank, and every promotion of a member of the 10 Police to any rank below the rank of Superintendent, shall be made only on the recommendation of the Promotion Board."
