### A BILL INTITULED

*New*

#### An Act to amend the Police Act 1958

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand  
5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:

1. **Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the Police Amend-  
ment Act 1961, and shall be read together with and deemed  
part of the Police Act 1958\* (hereinafter referred to as the  
10 principal Act).

2. **Appointment of Superintendents**—Section 7 of the  
principal Act is hereby amended by adding, as subsection  
(2) thereof, the following subsection:  
“(2) Any appointment under this section to the rank of  
15 Superintendent shall be made from those commissioned  
officers for the time being holding the rank of Chief  
Inspector.”

**3. Promotion Board to recommend certain appointments and promotions**—Section 13 of the principal Act is hereby amended by repealing subsection (1), and substituting the following subsection:

“ (1) Subject to the provisions of this Act, every appointment under section 7 or section 8 of this Act to any rank below the rank of Superintendent, every appointment under section 12 of this Act to any commissioned or non-commissioned rank, and every promotion of a member of the Police to any rank below the rank of Superintendent, shall be made only on the recommendation of the Promotion Board.”
