A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT relating to the Observance of certain Public and Bank Holidays. Title.

5 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Public and Bank Holidays Act, 1907. Short Title.

10 2. Whenever pursuant to any Act any holiday to which this Act applies would fall on any day other than a Monday, then the following Monday shall be observed as a public holiday and bank holiday instead of such day, and the provisions of any Acts relating to public holidays or bank holidays shall be deemed and taken to apply to such Monday. Holidays to be observed on Mondays.

15 3. This Act shall apply to the following holidays in each and every year, namely:— Holidays to which Act applies.

The anniversary of the birthday of His Majesty or his successor for the time being;

20 The anniversary of the birthday of His Royal Highness the Prince of Wales for the time being;

The anniversary days of the several provinces of New Zealand;

The seventeenth day of March, being Saint Patrick's Day;

The twenty-third day of April, being Saint George's Day;

25 The twenty-fourth day of May, being Empire Day; and

The thirtieth day of November, being Saint Andrew's Day.
