# PATRIOTIC AND CANTEEN FUNDS AMENDMENT BILL

# EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Bill makes three amendments to the Patriotic and Canteen Funds Act 1947.

Clause 2 repeals section 4 (1) (a) of the principal Act, which provides that the Governor-General is to be a member of the New Zealand Patriotic Fund Board.

Clause 3 consequentially re-enacts section 5 of the principal Act in an amended form. That section provides that the Governor-General shall be the Chairman of the Board, and also provides for the appointment of a Deputy Chairman. The new section 5 provides for appointment by the Board of both a Chairman and a Deputy Chairman.

Clause 4 increases the maximum unauthorized expenditure of the New Zealand Patriotic Fund Board and the Canteen Fund Board and Provincial Patriotic Councils from £50 to £250 a year.

# A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Patriotic and Canteen Funds Title. Act 1947.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New 5 Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Patriotic and Canteen Short Title. Funds Amendment Act 1952, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Patriotic and Canteen Funds 1947, No. 63 10 Act 1947 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Section four of the principal Act is hereby amended Membership of by repealing paragraph (a) of subsection one.

3. The principal Act is hereby amended by repealing Chairman and section five, and substituting the following section:

"5. (1) At the first meeting of the Board held after New Zealand 15 the passing of this section, and at the first meeting of the Board held after the first day of October in the year nineteen hundred and fifty-three, and in each succeeding financial year the Board shall appoint a Chairman and 20 a Deputy Chairman.

"(2) Any person appointed as the Chairman or Deputy Chairman shall hold office, while he continues to be a member of the Board, until the appointment of his successor in accordance with this section, and may be reappointed."

Amending provisions as to unauthorized expenditure.

4. Section thirty-six of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting the words "fifty pounds", and substituting the words "two hundred and fifty pounds".
