A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT for the further Amendment of "The Printers and News- Title.
papers Registration Act, 1868."

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in
5 Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as fol-
lows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Printers and Newspapers Short Title.
Registration Act Amendment Act, 1894."

10 2. "The Printers and Newspapers Registration Act, 1868," is Interpretation of
hereby amended as follows:— "print."

(1.) Section three: The following words shall be added thereto:—

15 "Print," in relation to any paper or book, means
printing by means of ordinary printing-type, and includes
engraving, lithographing, or producing by other mechanical
process such as chromography, calligraphy, or any imi-
tations thereof, or copying-press.

(2.) Section twenty: There shall be inserted the word "printed" Section 20 amended.
after the words "for every such copy so" where they
occur therein.

20 The said Act shall henceforth be read and operate as if it had been
originally enacted in manner as hereby amended.
