A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT for the further Amendment of "The Printers and News- Title.  
papers Registration Act, 1868."

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in  
5 Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as fol-  
lows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Printers and News- Short Title.  
papers Registration Act Amendment Act, 1895."

2. All references to printing contained in "The Printers and Interpretation of  
10 Newspapers Registration Act, 1868" (hereinafter called "the said  
Act"), shall, in relation to papers or books, be construed to mean  
and include—

15 Printing by means of ordinary printing type, engraving,  
lithographing, or producing by other mechanical process  
such as chromography, calligraphy, or any imitations  
thereof, or by copying-press.

3. Section twenty of the principal Act is hereby amended by Section 20 amended.  
inserting the word "printed" next before the word "published."
