A BILL INTITULED

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in
 Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
 follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be “The Permanent Approp- Short Title.

2. Notwithstanding any of the Acts or parts of Acts mentioned Salaries attached to
 certain offices to be,
 after present holders
 cease to hold office,
 subject to approp-
 riation.
 in the Second Schedule to the contrary, upon the person who at present
 holds any of the offices mentioned in the First Schedule hereto ceasing
 to hold such office, the salary from time to time thereafter payable to
 10 the holder of such office shall be such as shall from time to time be
 fixed by the General Assembly, and shall be subject to appropriation
 by the General Assembly.

3. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the Acts in Third
 Schedule to be con-
 strued as authorizing
 payments out of
 moneys to be
 appropriated.
 15 said Acts contained authorizing the payment out of the revenues of
 the Colony of any fees costs charges expenses or moneys for any
 purpose whatever, shall be construed as authorizing such payment
 out of moneys to be from time to time appropriated by the General
 Assembly.
