 - The Bail Amendment Bill, comprising subpart 1 of Part 2
 - The Sentencing Amendment Bill (No 3), comprising subpart 2 of Part 2, and Schedule 3
 - The Parole Amendment Bill (No 2), comprising subpart 3 of Part 2
 - This bill, comprising subpart 4 of Part 2.

Despite section 16 of the principal Act (as in force immediately before the commencement of this Act), subpart 1 of Part 2 of the principal Act is deemed to have continued in force after 30 June 2007.
