A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Public Bodies' Powers Act, 1887." Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Public Bodies' Powers Act 1887 Amendment Act, 1898." Short Title.

2. The words "leasing authority" in "The Public Bodies' Powers Act, 1887," shall be taken to extend to and include dock trusts. Definition of "leasing authority" in principal Act amended.
