This Public Bill originated in the House of Representatives, and, having this day passed as now printed, is transmitted to the LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL for its concurrence.

A BILL INTITULED

An Act to declare certain Private Ways in the Borough of Petone Title. to be Streets.

WHEREAS certain private ways known as Nevis Street, Armidale Preamble. 5 Street, and Lochy Street were, with the consent of the Petone Borough Council, laid out and constructed within the Borough of Petone in or about the year eighteen hundred and ninety-four, as shown on a plan deposited in the Land Registry Office at Wellington as No. 675, and have been used by the public uninterruptedly as 10 thoroughfares since the before-mentioned date: And whereas the owners of the lands adjoining the said private ways have come to an agreement with the Petone Borough Council for the payment to the said Council of a sum of money which in its opinion is sufficient to provide for the permanent construction of the said private ways: 15 And whereas the said Council is desirous that the said private ways should be declared streets:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :--

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Petone Borough Streets Act, short Title. 20 1924.
 - 2. The private ways described in the Schedule hereto are hereby Certain private ways declared as from the commencement of this Act to be streets within in Borough of Petone constituted the meaning of the Municipal Corporations Act, 1920.
