## A BILL INTITULED

### AN ACT to extend the Boundaries of the Peninsula County. Title.

**WHEREAS** by the creation of the Municipality of Caversham, in the Provincial District of Otago, a certain strip of land whereon runs the main road leading from the City of Dunedin to the Peninsula County has been severed from the County of Taieri, though still forming an outlying part of the last-named county: And whereas for purposes of administration it would be more convenient if the aforesaid strip of land were included within the boundaries of the Peninsula County: And it is expedient that, for the efficient maintenance and repair of the aforesaid Anderson's Bay Road, the Council of the Peninsula County should be authorized to collect tolls in respect of the traffic passing along the said road, and for that purpose to erect a tollgate on such road at some place within a less distance than a mile from the boundary of any borough: Preamble.

**BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED** by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**1.** The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Peninsula County Act, 1877." Short Title.

**2.** The boundaries of the Peninsula County, as the same are defined in the Schedule to "The Counties Act, 1876," are hereby repealed, and the said county shall henceforth have the boundaries set forth in the Schedule to this Act. Boundaries of Peninsula County extended.

**3.** All that portion of road generally known as the Anderson's Bay Road, leading from the City of Dunedin to the former boundary of the Peninsula County, shall be deemed a county road within the meaning of "The Public Works Act, 1876," and the Council of the Peninsula County shall have the care and management of the said road; and, notwithstanding anything contained in the one hundred and second section of the aforesaid "Public Works Act, 1876," it shall be lawful for the said Council to cause tolls to be collected upon the above-mentioned Anderson's Bay Road, and for that purpose may establish tollgates on any portion of the aforesaid road within a distance of one mile from the boundary of any borough. County Council may erect tollgate on Anderson's Bay Road.

## SCHEDULE.

## PENINSULA COUNTY.

Schedule.

Is bounded towards the North by the high watermark of the Otago Harbour from the Ocean Beach Railway line in Section No. 70, Block VII., Town District; towards the East and South by the ocean to a point where the line of high watermark is intersected by the production of the north-eastern boundary line of Section No. 79, Block VII., Town District; thence by that line and the north-western boundary of Section No. 79 and part of Section 80; thence by a right line across a road line and along the south-western boundary of Section No. 71 to the Anderson's Bay Road; thence along the southern boundary line of the said road to the Caversham Municipality; thence along the north-eastern boundary of the said municipality to the Dunedin Town Belt; thence by the Town Belt to lands granted to the Otago Harbour Board; again towards the North by the said lands granted to the Otago Harbour Board; thence by the north-eastern side of the Ocean Beach Railway to high watermark in Section No. 70, Block VII., Town District, the starting point.
