## A BILL INTITULED

An Act to authorize the Governor to grant or otherwise Title. assure to the Corporation of the Town of Port Chalmers certain lands as Compensation for Town Belt Land taken for the Dunedin and Moeraki Railway and for injury to Property belonging to the Corporation of such Town by such Railway.

WHEREAS the Dunedin and Moeraki Railway passes through Preamble. the entire extent of the Tewn Belt of Port Chalmers, and upwards of eight acres of such belthave been taken to construct the said railway, and the remaining past of the said belt is so cut up as 5 to render it nearly useless for the purposes for which it was originally set apart: And whereas by the construction of the said railway the said Town Belt and other property belonging to the Corporation of the said town has been injuriously affected to a large extent, and it is just and equitable to make compensation for the land so taken and 10 the property so injuriously affected:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Port Chalmers Short Title. 15 Compensation Act, 1877."

2. The Governor in Council may, upon the request of the Governor may grant Municipal Council of the Town of Port Chalmers, grant to the body to body corporate of Port Chalmers cercorporate of the said town in fee-simple, out of the waste lands of the tain lands. Crown in the Provincial District of Otago, three thousand acres of 20 land outside the limits of the said town.

3. The Governor may grant or otherwise assure to the said body Grant of land in corporate in fee-simple the piece of land described in the Schedule Schedule. No. 140—1.

Vesting of said land in said body corporate.

hereto. Upon the issue of suggrant or the execution of such assurance as aforesaid, the said jece of land shall vest in the body corporate, freed and discharge from any uses or trusts theretofore affecting such land.

Land vested to be held in trust as an endowment.

4. Any land vested in the body corporate under the provisions of this Act shall be held upor trust as an endowment in aid of the borough funds of the said tow, and may be dealt with and disposed of in all respects as the Muniipal Council of the said Town of Port Chalmers may from time to time think best.

Passing of Act a full and complete discharge.

5. The passing of this Ac shall be deemed a full and complete 10 discharge of all claims and emands which the said Town of Port Chalmers, or the body corporat thereof, are entitled to for the land so taken as aforesaid, or for any ijuries or damage arising through the construction of the said railway

No grant under Section 350 of "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1876," hereafter to be made to the said body corporate.

6. No grant shall hereafte be made to the body corporate of the 15 said town of Port Chalmers uner the provisions of the three hundred and fiftieth section of "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1876," notwithstanding such town may be constituted a borough under that Act; and, so far as regards the said town, the powers conferred by the said section are hereby revaed.

ALL that piece or parcel of land in te Provincial District of Otago containing by admeasurement 2 roods and 4 perche, more or less, situate partly within the area known as the Town Belt of Port Chalmrs and partly within the area known as Mussel Bay Reclamation, both of which areas at Crown granted to the Superintendent of Otago and his successors. Bounded towars the North-east by the Town Belt of Port Chalmers and other part of Mussel Bay reclamation 200 links; towards the South-east by at the North-apart of Mussel Bay reclamation 200 links; towards the South west by other by other part of Mussel Bay reclamatic 304.2 links; towards the South-west by other part of Mussel Bay reclamation and Town Belt of Port Chalmers 150 links; and towards the North-west by other part of Town 3elt of Port Chalmers 300 links.
