A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to enable the Funds belonging to a Domain Board to be operated on through the Post-Office Savings-Bank. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Public Domain Boards Funds Act, 1906." Short Title.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in "The Public Domains Act, 1881," or any amendment thereof, Domain Boards may lodge the Boards funds in the Post-Office Savings-banks; and no moneys shall be drawn out of such savings-banks except by authority of the Committee, contained in a written order signed by the Chairman and one other member of the Committee, such written order to be presented to the Postmaster on the withdrawal of any moneys by the Committee. Funds may be operated on through the Post-Office Savings-Bank.

3. The Governor may from time to time, by Order in Council gazetted, make regulations for carrying the provisions of this Act into effect. Regulations.
