- 1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Public Domain Boards Short Title. Funds Act, 1906."
- 2. Notwithstanding anything contained in "The Public Domains Funds may be 10 Act, 1881," or any amendment thereof, Domain Boards may lodge the Boards funds in the Post-Office Savings-banks; and no moneys Savings-Bank. shall be drawn out of such savings-banks except by authority of the Committee, contained in a written order signed by the Chairman and one other member of the Committee, such written order to be pre-15 sented to the Postmaster on the withdrawal of any moneys by the

3. The Governor may from time to time, by Order in Council Regulations. gazetted, make regulations for carrying the provisions of this Act into effect.
