PHYSICAL DRILL IN PUBLIC AND NATIVE SCHOOLS.

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to provide ~~that Education Boards shall cause~~ for the Teaching of Physical Drill to be taught to Boys and Girls attending in Public and Native Schools. Title.

5 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is “~~The State-school Children Drill~~ *Physical Drill in Public and Native Schools Act, 1901,*” and it shall be read with and form part of “*The Education Act, 1877.*” Short Title.

10 2. It shall be the duty of the Board of Education in each district constituted under “~~The Education Act, 1877,~~” to cause physical drill to be taught to all boys and girls over the age of eight years attending the public schools in the school district. Compulsory to teach physical drill to boys and girls attending public schools.

15 3. The Education Board of each district shall from time to time, with the approval of the ~~Governor in Council,~~ Minister, make regulations and orders for fixing the times which shall be appointed and set apart for instructing boys and girls of the required age in physical drill, and the mode in which such instruction shall be given. ~~and the Education Board of each district may from time to time, with the approval of the Governor in Council, alter or repeal any such regulations.~~ Education Board to make regulations.

25 4. Every Education Board shall furnish a quarterly report to the Minister of Education showing that the requirements of this Act and the regulations made thereunder are being complied with. Boards to furnish quarterly reports to Minister of Education.

5. Out of the vote provided for Native schools the Minister of Education shall make provision for the teaching of physical drill to all children over the age of eight years attending ~~Maori~~ such schools.

Boys and girls may  
be exempt from  
operation of Act.

6. Upon the principal teacher of any school being satisfied that any boy or girl is unfit to undergo physical drill, such boy or girl shall be exempted from being instructed in such drill. 5

Date Act comes into  
operation.

7. This Act shall come into operation on the *first* day of *January*, one thousand nine hundred and two.
