A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Products Export Act, 1903."

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Products Export Amendment Act, 1906"; and it shall form part of and be read together with "The Products Export Act, 1903" (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act").

Short Title.

2. Section two of the principal Act is hereby amended—

Interpretation.

(a.) By inserting therein the following:—

" 'Package' means every kind of receptacle or covering used for the packing of products ":

(b.) By repealing the definition of "products," and substituting in lieu thereof the following:—

" 'Products' means grain, meat, rabbits, hares, poultry, eggs, apples, pears, fruit-pulp, hops, and phormium."

3. Section three of the principal Act is hereby amended by repealing paragraph (c), and substituting in lieu thereof the following:—

Section 3 of principal Act amended.

(c.) Appoint any specified ports to be the only ports at which products or any specified product may lawfully be exported."
