**A BILL INTITULED**

**AN ACT to amend the Products Export Act, 1903.**

Title.

**BE IT ENACTED** by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

5 **1.** This Act may be cited as the Products Export Amendment Act, 1907, and shall form part of and be read together with the Products Export Act, 1903 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

Short Title.

10 **2.** Section two of the principal Act is hereby amended—

Section 2 of principal Act amended.

(a.) By inserting therein the following:—

“ ‘Package’ means every kind of receptacle or covering used for the packing of products ”:

15 (b.) By repealing the definition of “products,” and substituting therefor the following:—

“ ‘Products’ means grain, meat, rabbits, hares, poultry, eggs, apples, pears, fruit-pulp, hops, and phormium.”
