WHEREAS that part of the foreshore of Port Nicholson that lies Preamble. 5 opposite the seaward boundary of the Borough of Petone is now vested in the Wellington Harbour Board : And whereas it is expedient to transfer the said part of foreshore to the Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the said Borough :

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New 10 Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :---

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Petone Foreshore Short Title. Vesting Act, 1903."

2. The part of foreshore described in the Schedule to this Act Vesting of foreshore in Petone Borough
15 is hereby absolutely vested in and shall be under the control of the Corporation. Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of Petone.
