A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to vest the Foreshore opposite the Borough of Petone in the Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the said Borough. Title.

WHEREAS that part of the foreshore of Port Nicholson that lies opposite the seaward boundary of the Borough of Petone is now vested in the Wellington Harbour Board: And whereas it is expedient to transfer the said part of foreshore to the Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the said Borough: Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Petone Foreshore Vesting Act, 1903." Short Title.

2. The part of foreshore described in the Schedule to this Act is hereby absolutely vested in and shall be under the control of the Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of Petone. Vesting of foreshore in Petone Borough Corporation.
