## A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend "The Public Health Act, 1876."

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Public Health Act 1876 short Title.

2. Every Local Board of Health constituted under "The Public Further powers Health Act, 1876," shall have and may exercise the powers in in restraint of offensive trades. restraint of offensive trades given by sections seventy-six to seventy-10 nine, both inclusive, of the said Act, as well as the Local Board of a

No Local Board shall consent to the establishment by any Blood-boiling person of the trade of blood-boiler in premises situate within half a mile distance from any premises occupied as a dwelling-house, or as half a mile of 15 a shop, store, or factory of any kind wherein persons are employed inhabited houses.
