A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend "The Public Health Act, 1872."

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Public Health Act Short Title.

10 Amendment Act, 1875." 2. The nineteenth section of "The Public Health Act, 1872"

(hereinafter called "the said Act,") is hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof of "The Public Health Act, 1872;" it is hereby enacted that the Governor in Council may make orders Health Act, 1872;" from time to time directing that the provisions contained in sections lieu thereof. 15 twenty to forty-five of the said Act both inclusive, or any of them, be put in force in New Zealand, or in such parts thereof or in such places

therein as in such orders respectively may be expressed, and may in like manner revoke any such order; and subject to revocation every such order shall be in force for such period as shall be expressed in such 20 order, and in case no period shall be expressed in such order, then such order shall be in force until revocation thereof; and every such order shall be published in the Gazette, and such publication shall be conclusive evidence of such order to all intents and purposes; and none of the said provisions shall be in force in any part of New Zealand until 52 an order directing the same to be put in force shall have been made

and published as aforesaid: Provided that nothing herein contained shall affect any order Provise. made previous to the passing of this Act under the section of the said Act hereby repealed, but every such order shall be in force for such period as is stated in such order, and may be revoked or renewed as if the same had been made under this Act.
