A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Public Health Act, 1900."

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Public Health Amendment Act, 1901."

Short Title.

2. The Governor may, by Order in Council, from time to time prohibit the importation into New Zealand of any material liable to convey infectious diseases, and also stipulate any conditions under which such material may be admitted.

Prohibition as regards certain imports.

3. Notwithstanding anything in section eight of "The Public Health Act, 1900," the Governor may declare the Chatham Islands to be a public health district, and all provisions of that Act shall thereupon apply to such district.
