BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :---

2. (1.) The Governor may, by Order in Council, from time to Prohibition as time prohibit the importation into New Zealand of any material liable imports. which in his opinion is likely to convey infectious diseases, and also or stipulate any conditions under which such material may be admitted.

New subclause.

(2.) Any goods imported contrary to the provisions of any such Order in Council shall be deemed to be goods prohibited to be imported under "The Customs Laws Consolidation Act, 1882," and shall be dealt with accordingly.

New clause.

2a. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in section one hundred and seventy of "The Public Health Act, 1900," the certifibe granted by cate of exemption therein mentioned shall be granted by the Magistrate alone. Stipendiary Magistrate alone.

3. Notwithstanding anything in section eight of "The Public Chatham Islands a Health Act, 1900," the Governor may declare the Chatham Islands to be a public health district, and all provisions of that Act shall thereupon apply to such district.
